

RASKOLNIKOV'S REDEMPTION

Get ready to sip on a cocktail as intense as *Crime and Punishment* itself! This dark, brooding drink captures all the drama and redemption of the ballet in one delicious sip. Here's your recipe to taste the mood:

INGREDIENTS:

2 oz Vodka

(a nod to the Russian setting)

1 oz Blackberry Liqueur

(for a dark, deep fruit flavor representing Raskolnikov's internal struggles)

1 oz Cold Brew Coffee

(symbolizing the tension and sleepless nights)

½ oz Simple Syrup

(to balance the bitterness with a hint of sweetness)

A dash of Angostura bitters

(representing the complexity of guilt and redemption)

Fresh blackberries and lemon peel

for garnish

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Fill a shaker with ice, and add vodka, blackberry liqueur, cold brew coffee, simple syrup, and bitters.
2. Shake vigorously to combine all the ingredients.
3. Strain into a chilled coupe glass.
4. Garnish with fresh blackberries and a lemon peel twist to add a touch of brightness, symbolizing hope and redemption.

This cocktail is rich, complex, and slightly bitter with just enough sweetness to represent the light at the end of Raskolnikov's dark journey.
